SOARING AT EDGEMONT!

You might hear your child talk about SOARING at Edgemont. We have a set of behavior expectations at Edgemont that help us SOAR at school and we can use your help talking about them at home too. SOAR stands for Safety - stay safe, Ownership - owning our actions, Achievement - always doing our best, and Respect - respecting everyone and everything. These four values help everyone know the expectations in each part of our school. When school staff see students following SOAR expectations, they may give them a SOAR card. Your child keep the white part to take home and celebrate with you and also places the yellow card in a drawing that we do each week. We love to see our Edgemont Eagles SOAR!
