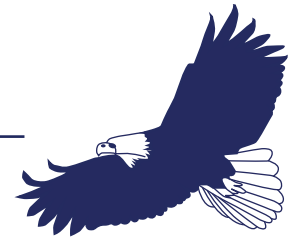


# Edgemont Elementary School

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Provo UT 84604

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Dear Parents/Legal Guardians,

Our school has experienced a recent increase in positive COVID-19 cases and will implement the state mandated Test to Stay protocol ([SB107](#)). This protocol is in place to allow the continuation of face-to-face instruction and extracurricular activities.

The state requires a Test to Stay event when a school reaches the established threshold of positive COVID-19 cases:

- 2% of students test positive for COVID-19 within the previous 14 days at schools with 1,500 or more students
- 30 students test positive for COVID-19 within the previous 14 days at schools with fewer than 1,500 students.

## Utah Department of Health Test to Stay State Guidelines

By law, parent/legal guardian consent is required to test students under the age of 18. In conjunction with school and district personnel, the State and County Health Departments will conduct the testing for students. The Test to Stay Date for Edgemont Elementary will be held on Friday, October 8th. We will test using the following [schedule](#). Prior to testing, all students MUST be registered in the secure State REDCap system, specific for our school.

## REGISTRATION FORM FOR PROVO CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

There are three possible Test to Stay outcomes:

1. **Positive Test:** Students who test positive must isolate at home. They may return to in-person learning and extracurricular activities after they complete their 10-day isolation period.
2. **Negative Test:** Students who test negative and do not have any symptoms of COVID-19 may continue in-person learning and extracurricular activities.
3. **Did Not Participate:** Student who do not participate should quarantine at home for 10 days. They may return to in-person learning and extracurricular activities after 10 days.

If your student is absent from the Test to Stay event, the parent/legal guardian must seek testing on their own and provide the school with their test results to receive clearance to return to school. The COVID-19 test must be provided by your healthcare provider or an **approved alternate test location** within two days of the Test to Stay event. At home PCR or antigen tests will not be accepted.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Students do NOT have to participate in the Test to Stay event if they:

- tested positive for COVID-19 within 90 days,
- are fully vaccinated,
- participated in community testing on 04 October 2021 AND received a negative test result.

**Please make sure to bring documentation to the nurses at the time of school testing.**

We appreciate your cooperation to help our school community be safe and healthy.
