

# IT'S SKI SCHOOL TIME!

WHAT? Five weeks of <u>ski</u> or <u>snowboard</u> lessons from instructors at Sundance. WHEN? January 5, 12, 19, 26 & February 2nd from 2 to 4:30 pm HOW is this possible? Please thank Principal Kartchner for allowing ski school to continue! <u>Ski School is a voluntary, parent-run program not sponsored by Edgemont Elementary or Provo School District.</u>

<u>Sign up DEADLINE is DECEMBER 2nd</u>. Registration will be online via FareHarbor, just like last year. https://fareharbor.com/embeds/book/sundanceschoolprograms/items/189517/?full-items=yes

- 1. Click on the link above.
- 2. On the small calendar located on the right side of the screen, click on the date of the first program. It should be the only date you can click, highlighted in blue.
- 3. A box should appear under the calendar with the program name, click it.
- 4. Enter in the number of participants.
- 5. Enter each participant's legal first and last name.
- 6. Choose the lesson type (Skiing or Snowboarding).
- 7. Enter your child's experience level. (Please see attached documents for both ski and snowboard experience level description.)
- 8. Check the box of any add-ons your child may need or want. If your child does not have a season pass, you MUST check the "purchase lift ticket" box. If your child needs a ski or snowboard rental, check the equipment rental box. You do not have to get rentals through Sundance, but it does make life easier because you don't have to carry equipment to and from a shop in the valley. If you want to rent a helmet you may. Helmets are recommended but not required.
- 9. Fill out your name, phone number, and email address in the contact section. This is the information we use as your child's emergency contact so please fill it out completely!
- 10. Fill in the payment section with your card information and press "Complete your booking."
- 11. You should get a confirmation email with links to waivers that must be signed in order to participate.

### **GENERAL INFO:**

**AGE LIMITS:** Skiers must be at least 8 years old to participate (by January). Snowboarders must be at least 9 years old to participate (by January).

**LESSON COST:** \$312.50 with a season pass or \$437.50 for non-season pass holders, plus any rentals.

**TRANSPORTATION COST:** A Provo school bus will take the kids to and from Sundance. The cost is \$5/week (\$25 total) and is in addition to and separate from the fees you pay to Sundance. Please Venmo Amie Page (@Amie-Page) by Dec. 2nd.

**OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT RENTAL**: Sundance Ski or Snowboard rental is \$100 for 5 weeks (\$20 per week) or bring your own equipment. Helmet rental: \$25 for 5 weeks (\$5 per week). Helmets are recommended but not required. Local sporting goods stores also offer season rentals.

# WHAT LEVEL OF **SKIER** AM I? (Sundance School Programs)

#### **RED**

Level 1: Never skied before.

#### GREEN

- Level 2: You can stop and make slight wedge turns.
- Level 3: You can make round wedge turns.
- Level 4: You can make controlled wedge turns with a parallel, skidded finish.

#### BLUE

- Level 5: You can match your skis parallel in the middle of the "wedge Christie" turn.
- Level 6: You can start turns with a slight wedge opening then quickly match to a parallel. You have a pole plant.
- Level 7: You can link open-stance parallel turns.

# WHAT LEVEL OF **SNOWBOARDER** AM I? (Sundance School Programs)

#### **RFD**

- Level 1: Never been on a snowboard.
- Level 2: Should be able to do a slide slip, falling leaf, and J-Turn.

#### GREEN

- Level 3: Should be able to do C-turns, S-turns, on the green terrain.
- Level 4: Should be able to control turn shape, do dynamic skidded stop & be working on flat surface 180's.

### BLUE

- Level 5: Should be able to do basic carve, ride switch, and be working on jumps and grabs.
- Level 6: Should be able to do everything listed above plus ride powder, bumps, and steeps.
